Pallavi Pratap, managing partner of Pratap & Co, said non-registration of charge should not be fatal to the claim of a secured financial creditor because a look at Rules 3 and 4 of the Companies (Registration of Charges) Rules, 2014, show that the onus of registration of charge is on the compa-

The company had posted net profit of ₹1,017 crore in the same period last year. During the quarter, revenue from operations declined marginally to ₹15,698 crore, from ₹15,738 crore in the year-ago period.

Consolidated ebitda during the quarter rose 23% to ₹3,808 crore on the back of rampedup solar manufacturing, favorable regulatory development in distribution, and operational efficiency across businesses, the company said.

"All our business segments have performed remarkably well during the quarter leading to 20th consecutive quarterly PAT growth," said CEO and MD Praveer Sinha.

Mumbai: Google India recorded an 11% increase in gross advertising revenue, reaching ₹31,221 crore for the financial year ending March 31, 2023, compared to ₹28,040 crore in the year-ago period, according to its filings with the Registrar of Companies.

The company paid ₹28,477 crore to Google Asia Pacific Pte Ltd for the purchase of ad space, reflecting an 11% rise from last year's ₹25,717 crore.

As a leading player in search and digital video advertising space, Google India earned ₹2,743 crore in net advertising revenue, an 18% increase from the previous year. The company owns marketleading products and services including the likes of Google Search, Play Store, YouTube, Chrome, and Google Maps.

Gross sales from enterprise products rose by 35% to ₹1,551 crore. Google India paid ₹1,396 crore to Google Asia Pacific for services related to enterprise products, up

Meta India FY24 Ad Revenue Logs 24% Growth

Mumbai: Meta India posted a 24% growth in gross advertising revenue, reaching ₹22,730 crore for the fiscal year ending on 31 March, compared to ₹18,308 crore in the previous fiscal year, as per the company's filings with the RoC.

The Indian unit of global social media giant Meta Platforms, which still operates under the legal name Facebook India Online Services, recorded a modest 13% growth in gross advertising revenue for the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2023.

The FY23 gross advertising revenue of ₹18,308 crore includes ₹6,120 crore from gross advertising reseller revenue, as the reseller model was in effect for a few months of that financial year.

Meta-which operates platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and WhatsApp-—has experienced strong monetisation from both major advertisers and small and medium-sized businesses (SMBs). Earlier, media agency GroupM projected that digital advertising revenue would grow by 13% in 2024, reaching ₹88,502 crore. Meta India declined to comment on the financials.

In August 2022, Meta India transitioned from a reseller to an operating licence model, granting the company a non-exclusive licence to commercialise intellectual property (IP) related to advertising sales activities in India.

Under this new arrangement, the company compensates Meta Platforms with royalty payments for commercialising its IP, along with infrastructure charges for maintaining infrastructure. The shift to the operating licence model led Meta India to pay Meta Platforms increased royalties, which rose 95% to ₹17,887 crore in FY24. It also paid ₹5,666 crore to Meta Platforms for the cost of ad inventory. Infrastructure costs rose 89% to ₹2,922 crore.

Despite increased royalty and infrastructure expenses, Meta India's net advertising revenue, excluding the royalties paid to Meta Platforms, climbed 49% year-on-year, reaching ₹1,817 crore in FY24.

Meta India's operating revenue grew by 9.3% to₹3,034 crore, although other income declined by 26% to ₹29 crore. Total expenses rose by 2% to ₹2,349 crore, including an employee benefit expense of ₹476 crore, marking an 8% year-on-year increase.

Airtel to Shift 5G Mobile to 'Standalone' Mode in 4 Years

Kolkata: Bharti Airtel will

fully migrate its 5G mobile broadband services to the standalone (SA) mode in the next 3-4 years as demand picks up and as more 4G users upgrade to the nextgen service, the telco's senior management told analysts at the Sunil Mittal-led telco's fiscal second-quarter earnings call. Airtel's leadership, though, told analysts that the telco is in no hurry to migrate its 5G mobile services to the SA mode as it will need to spend another ₹30,000-40,000 crore on sub-GHz 5G spectrum for this. A 5G SA network architecture operates independently without using a telco's existing 4G infra. It is designed to offer the full capabilities of 5G mobile broadband technology, including a superior voice experience, faster data speeds and more flexibility in network deployment and operations. "For consumer 5G, the aim

is to gradually transition to SA (mode) based on demand, devices and freeing up of spectrum bands as more traffic migrates to 5G from 4G," IIFL Securities said in a research note, quoting Airtel's management during the earnings call.
